



A service project for rank advancement must be done specifically for your advancement. The listed service project requirements must be followed exactly for the service project to be counted. Service time does not include transportation time or eating time. Please use this form for approval.

1. **A Scout is Helpful. (3rd point of the Scout Law)**
2. Project must be approved by *both* the Patrol Advisor and the Scoutmaster.
3. Projects can be done by yourself or with your Patrol or Troop.
4. Projects must be pre-approved before they are begun.
5. 2nd Class projects can include Troop related projects (clean scout shed, equip. demonstrations, etc.)
6. Star and Life projects are to help the community, Church, or school. They can not be Troop related projects. Helping with an Eagle project counts. The projects must consist of 6 hours of work and must be pre-approved. (highway cleanup, Eagle projects, etc.)
7. The Scoutmaster will keep these records in your Patrol file. He will give them back at a Scoutmasters conference.
