



## **Uniform**

Required uniform items Scouts must purchase (Class "A"):

- Official BSA Scout shirt. These are available in short or long sleeve versions, short sleeve is recommended for year round use.
- Official BSA shoulder loops. (Boy Scouts wear green, Cub Scouts wear blue)
- Official council shoulder patch (must be sewn onto uniform shirt)
- Official BSA Troop numerals (must be sewn onto uniform shirt)
- Official BSA metal neckerchief slide
- Official BSA handbook

Required uniform items Troop 214 provides:

- Custom Troop 214 red neckerchief

Recommended and optional uniform items:

- Class "B" t-shirt (highly recommended); available from the Troop
- Official BSA cap (optional)
- Official BSA belt (optional)
- Official BSA pants or shorts (optional)
- Official BSA socks (optional)

Note: optional items are not recommended when first joining

## **Troop Policy**

- Scouts are required to follow the Troop 214 uniform policy.
- During the school year Scouts are required to wear their class "A" uniform to all meetings and Scouting events. On special occasions it is allowed to wear a class "B", those special occasions will be announced at Troop meetings.
- When school is not in session class "B" shirts may be worn to all meetings and Scouting events. On special occasions Scouts might be required to wear their class "A", those special occasions will be announced at Troop meetings.
- Full Class "A" uniforms are required at all Board of Reviews, Court of Honors, and Camporees.
- A full class "A" uniform includes: Official BSA shirt with correct patches sewn on, scarf (Troop or other Scout related), neckerchief slide (BSA or other Scout related), and Merit Badge Sash. Optional items are BSA pants or shorts, BSA belt, BSA socks, and BSA cap.
- Any Scout related t-shirt is considered to be a class "B" uniform shirt. But the official class "B" uniform shirt of Troop 214 is the red t-shirt that may be purchased directly from the Troop. The red Troop 214 t-shirt is required to be worn when traveling as a Troop to or from any Scouting activity.
