The jobs connected with your meals boil down to three main areas: fuel & water, cooking and clean-up. The assignment of responsibilities is based on the buddy system: the Scouts "Buddy up" on the jobs while the Patrol Leader is free of regular assignment so he can give a hand where needed. It is his job to see that everything gets done.

Assignments change after each meal. Scouts will rotate in a clockwise movement as shown in the sample below. Scout 1 moves to the position Scout 2 was in, Scout 2 moves to the position Scout 3 was in, Scout 3 moves to the position that Scout 4 was in and so on. Everyone gets a new buddy for each meal.

Note to Patrol Leader:

Get into a huddle with the gang. Then line up the 1st meal buddies. Be sure ALL the Scouts know the responsibilities they will have.

Fuel & Water Buddies:

Maintain water supply and supplies of fuel and fire wood. Start fires and stoves in time for cooks to have the meals ready on time.

Cooking Buddies:

Assemble food supplies, follow menus and recipes exactly, serve meals on time, put away food, put cook pots in to soak, make sure cleanup water is on the stoves.

Cleanup Buddies:

Set up wash and rinse water for dish washing, clean cooking pots and utensils, cleanup kitchen and dining area, store equipment, dispose of garbage, trash.
