



Dear Parents:

In past years Troop 214 has occasionally had problems with discipline at the meetings and campouts. We understand that boys will be boys, but there is a safety issue involved. For this reason we have adopted the following agreement for meetings and campouts to help resolve this problem.

- If a Scout directly disobeys rules involving the safety of himself or others, or the Scout is out of control, his parent(s) will be called and they will come and pick him up from either the meeting or the campout.
- If a parent(s) will be gone from home during a campout, it is the parent(s) responsibility to give the Scoutmaster a written statement of who should be contacted in case of discipline problems.
- If a parent(s) will be gone from home during a campout, it is the parent(s) responsibility to give the Scoutmaster a written statement of who should be contacted in case of an emergency.

The Troop 214 Scout leaders feel that we must not let these types of problems get out of hand. It makes the meetings and campouts no fun for anyone. Please read this letter with your Scout and make sure your Scout understands that you will pick him up if there is a problem.
